Conducted in two rounds (2009–10 and 2016–17), it provides key insights for monitoring tobacco control progress under the National Tobacco Control Programme.

2.1	Data description	Nationally representative self-administered, school-based survey of students of 13 to 15 years of age that collects data on tobacco use and related indicators in India. Conducted in four rounds (2003, 2006, 2009, 2019) it provides key insights on attitudes, behaviors, and knowledge about tobacco product use, intent to use, exposure to tobacco use, and exposure to tobacco product marketing and advertising for supporting policies under the National Tobacco Control Programme.
